

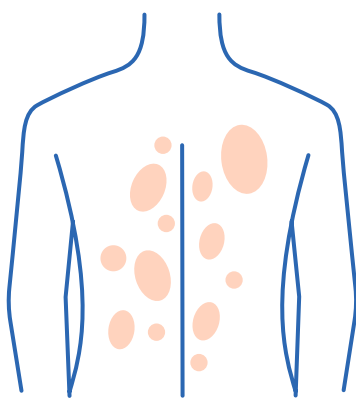
Get the treatment you need without a visit to the GP

Treatment for shingles

If you have one of the following symptoms, you may have shingles:

- painful blistering rash
- a tingling, burning sensation on the skin.

If you are aged 18 years and older, you may be able to get treatment at the chemist.

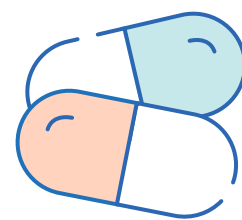


Treatment for urinary tract infections (UTIs)

If you have any of the following symptoms, you may have a urinary tract infection:

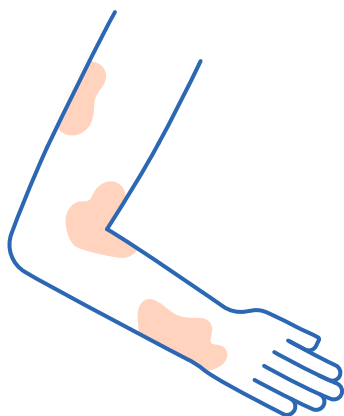
- stinging or burning when passing urine
- feeling the need to pass urine frequently or bladder still feels full after passing urine.

If you are female and aged between 16–65 years you may be able to get treatment at the chemist.



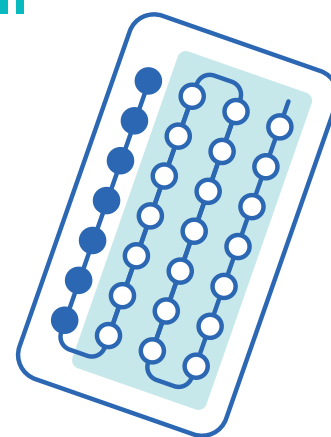
Treatment for a flare up of mild plaque psoriasis

If you are aged 18 years and older and currently have a flare-up of mild plaque psoriasis, you may be able to get a resupply of your cream or ointment from the chemist.



Resupply of an oral contraceptive pill

If you are aged 16–50 years and currently take an oral contraceptive pill, speak to the pharmacist to check if you can get a resupply.



Travel and vaccines

If you are travelling overseas or need a public health vaccine, participating chemists can administer a range of travel vaccinations as well as hepatitis A, hepatitis B, poliomyelitis, and typhoid vaccines (for people aged 5 years and older).
