For too long, women's health has been dismissed. We had to get better so every girl, woman and gender-diverse person can access better care, better information and better health outcomes through free women's health services across Victoria.

We are improving the system so you can improve your health too.

Free women's healthcare

Women across Victoria can now access free or low-cost specialist healthcare for women's health conditions, including:

- pelvic pain
- endometriosis
- incontinence
- menopause
- heavy bleeding
- sexual health testing and treatment
- abortion care

Women's Health Clinics

Specialist care for women's health conditions including endometriosis, pelvic pain, heavy bleeding, prolapse, menopause management, abortion care and contraception.

Virtual Women's Health Clinic

Specialist care by phone or video appointment. You can receive care from your home or from any location.

Women's Sexual and Reproductive Health Hubs

Care for sexual and reproductive health concerns, including all types of contraception, sexual health testing and treatment, and pregnancy options such as abortion care.

Mobile Women's Health Clinic

A travelling service for rural and regional communities. It provides advice, support and important health checks such as cervical screening and bowel screening.
